Steps to Connect

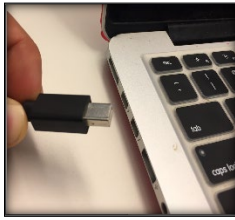

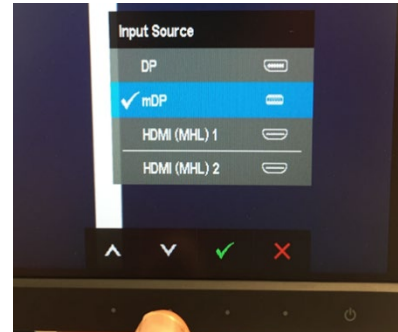
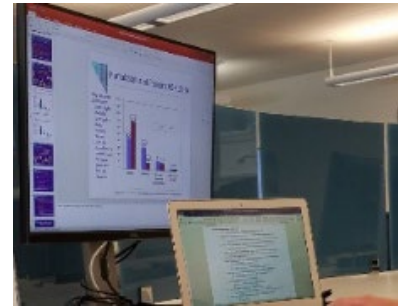

1. Insert the cable that fits your laptop.
2. Press the input button next to the power button on the monitor
3. Press the up/down arrows to select the corresponding input source.
4. Select the button for the green arrow to save the selection






KEY

Select mDP for mDP cables
(Fig 1)

Select HDMI 1 for USB – C cables
(Fig 2)

Select HDMI 2 for HDMI
(Fig 3)
